

OFFICIAL CALL

Mass Meeting of Charlottesville Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Charlottesville Republican Committee, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Dan Moy do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Jefferson Madison Regional Library, Central Branch at 10:00 AM local time on Saturday, September 26, 2026 for the following purposes:

- a) Electing up to 100 Delegates and 100 Alternates to the Fifth District Convention, to be held on November 14, 2026 beginning at 10:00 AM at the Thomas Gymnasium at Fork Union Military Academy, 4744 James Madison Highway, Fork Union, VA 23055 for the purpose of electing a Fifth District Chair.
- b) and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Charlottesville, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Prefiling Requirements

Candidates for the election or nomination at said mass meeting shall prefile the attached, completed and signed Delegate File Form with payment by mail or in person, to Jim Moore, 1213 Hazel Street, Charlottesville, VA 22902 and must be received no later than Wednesday, September 23, 2026, 5:00 pm. The Delegate File Form is attached to this email. For any questions concerning submitting application and payment, contact Jim Moore at jmoore125@gmail.com.

Registration Fee

Although there is not a registration fee for this mass meeting, delegate applicants are required to include a \$20 Fifth District Convention fee with their application. Checks must be made payable to "Charlottesville Republican Committee."

Military Members

Military members currently serving on active duty may be certified as delegates by complying with the prefiling procedures above. Military member delegates or alternate delegates unable to attend the convention due to official military orders will have their votes cast within their unit delegation according to candidate preference ballots.

Cancellation

In the event the number of qualified persons filing to become delegates to the Fifth District Convention does not exceed the 100 delegates and 100 alternates allowed from Charlottesville, this mass meeting will be cancelled and all properly prefiling and certified delegates will be deemed elected.
